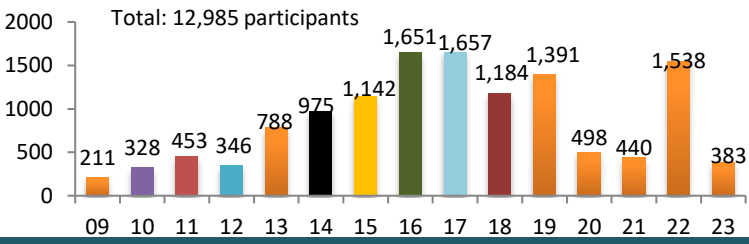

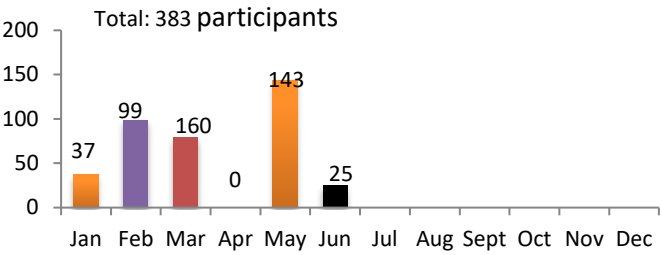

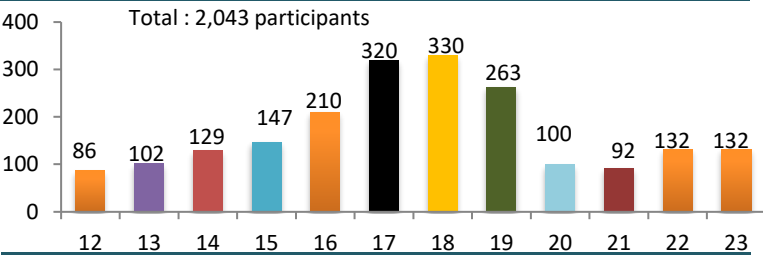
Total number of participants attending CePSWaM Courses from 2009 – 2023



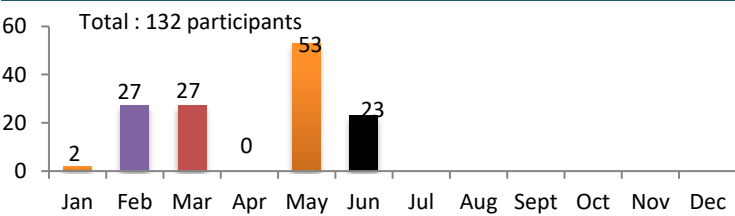
Number of participants attending CePSWaM Courses for Jan – Dec 2023



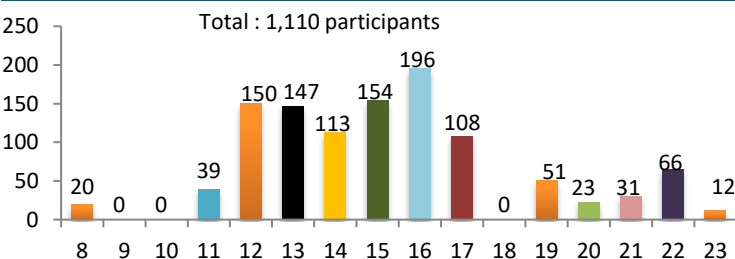
Number of participants attending CePSWaM Technical Report Preparation Workshops (TRPW) from 2012 - 2023



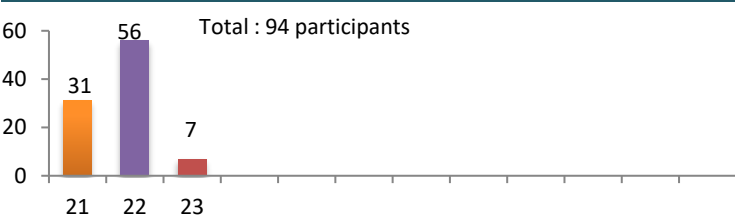
Number of participants attending CePSWaM Technical Report Preparation Workshops (TRPW) for Jan – Dec 2023

Requirements under Regulation 9 of Environmental Quality (Scheduled Wastes) Regulation 2005

Regulation 9 – Wastes Containers of Scheduled Wastes

- Scheduled wastes shall be stored in containers which are compatible with the scheduled wastes to be stored, durable and which are able to prevent spillage or leakage of the scheduled waste into the environment.
- Incompatible scheduled wastes shall be stored in separate containers, and such containers shall be placed in separate secondary containment areas.
- Containers containing scheduled wastes shall always be closed during storage except when it is necessary to add or removed the scheduled wastes.
- Area for the storage of the containers shall be designed, constructed and maintained adequately in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the Director General to prevent spillage or leakage of scheduled wastes into the environment.

Requirements under Regulation 10 of Environmental Quality (Scheduled Wastes) Regulation 2005

Regulation 10 – Labelling of Scheduled Wastes

- The **date** when the scheduled wastes are first generated, **name**, **address** and **telephone number** of the waste generator shall be clearly labelled on the containers that are used to store the scheduled wastes.
- Containers of scheduled wastes shall be clearly labelled in accordance with the type applicable to them as specified in the **Third Schedule** and marked with the scheduled waste code as specified in the **First Schedule** for identification and warning purposes.
- No person is allowed to alter the markings and labels mentioned in subregulations (1) and (2).

RINSE!
Rinse exposed skin and hair with water/saline for 30 minutes.

ANTIDOTE!
*Calcium gluconate
*Apply immediately, copiously and repeatedly.
*If ingestion; IV CaGlu 10%.
*If ocular burn; 1% CaGlu eyewash solution or 0 – 13% benzalkonium chloride.

Admission to ICU if:
*>4 inches burn surface area.
*Exposure to gaseous HFA.
*Severe electrolyte disturbances (consider hemodialysis)

Chemical Handling Safety Tips

- 1 Drink eight glasses of water or two liters a day.
- 2 Spend more time doing activities at inside home.

- 5 Wear thin and bright clothes such as white.
- 6 Avoid drinking caffeinated water.
- 7 Stop doing aggressive exercise. Do exercise only in the early morning or late afternoon only.
- 8 Get enough sleep. Do not exceed the number of hours recommended by age group.
- 9 Quit smoking and vaping.

CHECK THE LABEL



Before you use any chemical, read the label. Know exactly what it is and follow the warnings.

KNOW THE PLAN

Safe handling doesn't happen by accident. Check your response plan and know what to do if something goes wrong.




KEEP AIR FLOWING




If you can smell it, fumes are in the air! Good circulation is essential. Work in an area that's well ventilated and has a filtration system.

WEAR YOUR PPE

Goggles, face masks, gloves, coveralls, etc. Be sure to put on protective equipment every time (not just when the boss is looking.)



EMERGENCY AREAS



Before using dangerous chemicals, be sure you know where the nearest eyewash and shower areas are in case a quick wash-down is needed.

STAY ORGANIZED

Sloppy housekeeping can be dangerous when it comes to chemicals. Seal containers tightly, use proper labeling, and keep the area neat & tidy.
