## AWWAM MESSAGE

### Lockout/Tagout Compliance: Protect Yourself and Your Team

- Lockout/Tagout (LOTO) procedures are essential to prevent the unexpected energization of machinery during maintenance activities.
- Compliance with OSHA Standard 29 CFR 1910.147 mandates the isolation and secure locking/tagging of all energy sources prior to commencement of work.

#### Key steps for effective LOTO implementation include:

- Identification of all potential energy sources associated with the equipment.
  - Proper isolation and application of locks and tags to energy control devices.
  - Clear communication through standardized tags indicating the maintenance status.
  - Verification of equipment de-energization before any maintenance work proceeds.
  - Removal of locks and tags exclusively by the authorized personnel who applied them.
- Adherence to LOTO protocols is vital for safeguarding personnel and maintaining a safe operational environment.

**Lock it out tag it tight —  
keep your team safe day and night.**

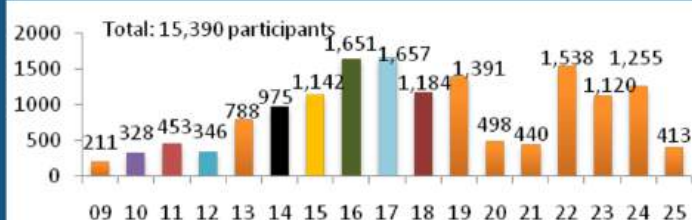

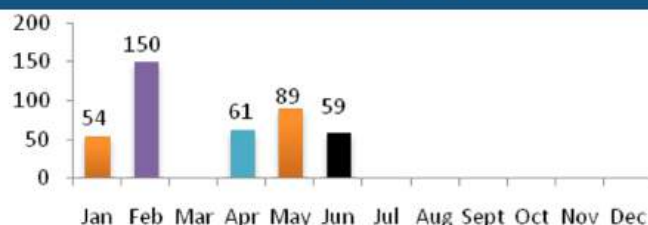

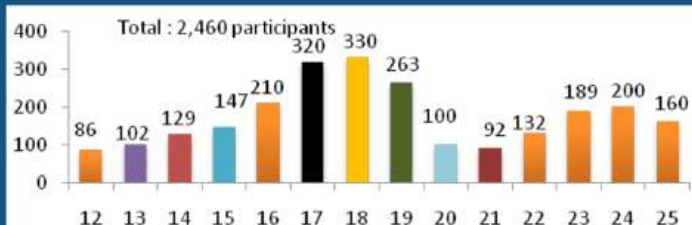
Total number of participants attending CePSWaM Courses from 2009 - 2025



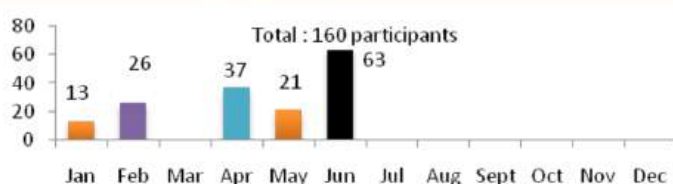
Number of participants attending CePSWaM Courses for Jan - Dec 2025



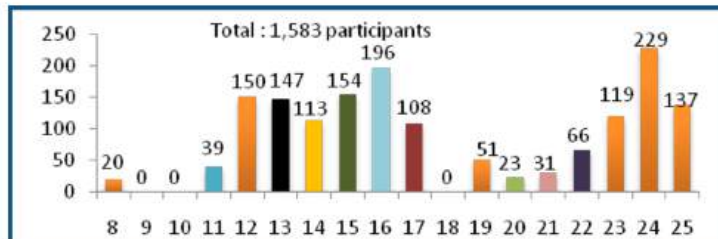
Number of participants attending CePSWaM-FTR Workshops (TRPW) from 2012 - 2025



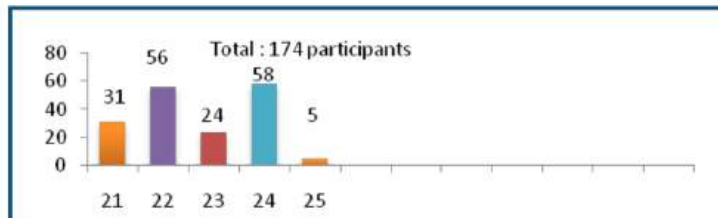
Number of participants attending CePSWaM-FTR Workshops (TRPW) for Jan - Dec 2025
