




Total number of participants attending CePSWaM Courses from 2009 – 2026




Number of participants attending CePSWaM Courses for Jan – Dec 2026




Number of participants attending CePSWaM-FTR Workshops (TRPW) from 2012 - 2026




Number of participants attending CePSWaM-FTR Workshops (TRPW) for Jan – Dec 2026
